

Connell is a small town of roughly 5,000 located in Southeastern Washington State and home to one of the greatest concentrations of public art in the Pacific Northwest. Divided into three interrelated groups, the art pieces reflect both the history and environment of the community.



Along Columbia Avenue, you'll find six world class Bronze and cast concrete sculptures by artist **Tom Otterness** entitled, **Wild Life**. These interactive sculptures depict local animals in a variety of whimsical situations and have proven very popular with both adults and children alike.



Enjoy free parking while taking a walking tour of our town or have a picnic lunch, sitting at the table with one of the **Otterness Bronzes**.

Six forged and painted steel flowers, from 12 to 17 ft. tall, line the fenced walking path along Highway 395-These are the work of **Jean Whitesavage** and **Nick Lyle** entitled, **Prairie Flowers, Potato and Wheat**.

Walking Guide

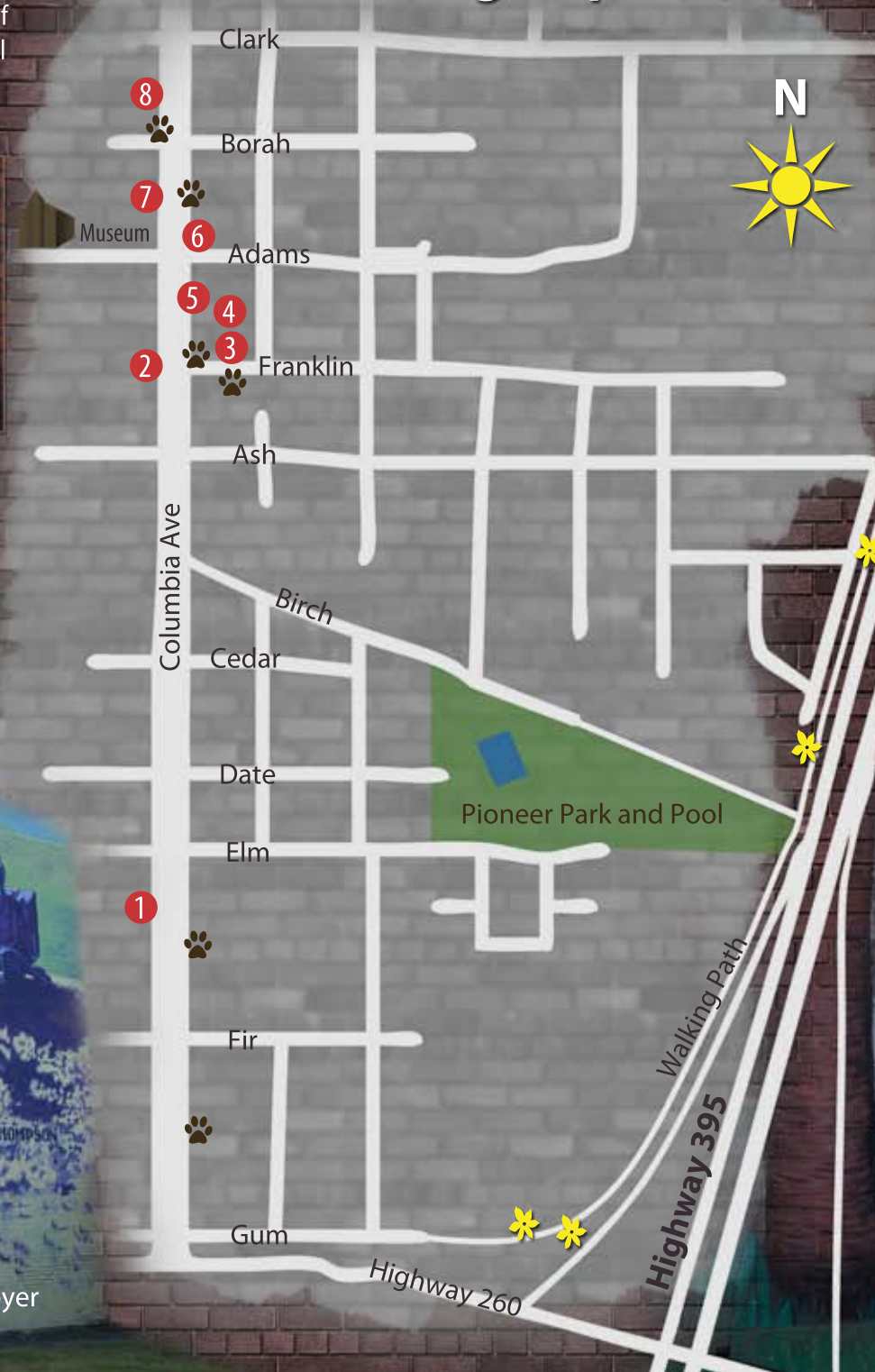
On Columbia Ave are several vibrant murals depicting events in local history. Most were created between 2005 and 2009 by artist Pat Boyer. Many can be found on the individual panels of Connell's City Hall, in a style called trompe l'oeil meaning "fool the eye". This style creates an illusion of the art being carved from the actual wall.



The art of Tom Otterness, Jean Whitesavage and Nick Lyle was developed in coordination with the Washington State Arts Commission in partnership with the Department of Corrections and the City of Connell. The art of Pat Boyer was developed in coordination with local owners and the Connell Downtown Development Association.
